

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC TEST AND INSPECTION CONDUCTED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSION OF KANAWHA COUNTY, WEST VIRGINIA, HELD AT THE VOTER REGISTRATION OFFICE LOCATED AT 415 QUARRIER STREET, CHARLESTON, WEST VIRGINIA ON THE 14TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 2011 FOR THE OCTOBER 4, 2011 GENERAL GUBERNATORIAL ELECTION.

The County Commission of Kanawha County, West Virginia convened at 8:45 a.m. on September 14, 2011 at the Voter Registration Office located at 415 Quarrier Street, Charleston, West Virginia for the Public Test and Inspection for the October 4, 2011 General Gubernatorial Election.

Present were W. Kent Carper, President, Henry C. Shores, Commissioner, Dave Hardy, Commissioner, Jennifer Sayre, County Manager, Vera McCormick, County Clerk, Gerald Drucker, County Clerk (Record Room), Pat Fisher, Registrar, Patty Kirk, Mark Dawson, and Rodney Coles, Voter Registration, and Democratic Ballot Commissioner Sandra Kay Miller.


The County Commission began the Public Inspection at 8:45 a.m. A total of 30 ballots were scanned through the M100s. The County Clerk verified the over-vote, under-vote, and no-vote ballots were included as part of the test. Vera McCormick verified 30 ballots were sufficient for the test and each piece of equipment that will be used for early voting was included in the test. The County Clerk and the Commissioners verified that the test was run and correctly tabulated. Commissioner Shores moved to approve the results of the public test. Commissioner Hardy seconded. Motion carried. It was verified the memory cards were returned to zero balance and secured within the machines, the County Clerk's Office is the only holder of the key to unlock the memory cards. Vera McCormick verified all materials of the test will be maintained for 22 months. At 9:05, the doors leading to the early voting machines were secured by the Commissioners and the Clerk, and will remain locked until September 20th when preparation will begin for early voting to take place on September 21-October 1, 2011.

Commissioner Shores moved to adjourn from the Public Test and Inspection. Commissioner Hardy seconded. Motion carried.


