

Minutes of the Public Pre-Test and After-Test Inspection conducted by the County Commission of Kanawha County, West Virginia, held at the Voter Registration Office at 415 Quarrier Street, Charleston, West Virginia, on the 4th day of October, 2011, for the October 4, 2011, General Gubernatorial Election.

The County Commission of Kanawha County convened at 6:55 p.m. on October 4, 2011, at the Voter Registration Office located at 415 Quarrier Street, Charleston, West Virginia, to conduct the public pre-test and inspection for the October 4, 2011, General Election. Present were: W. Kent Carper, President, Henry C. Shores, Commissioner, Dave Hardy, Commissioner, Marc J. Slotnick, County Attorney, Jennifer Sayre, County Manager, Vera J. McCormick, County Clerk, Pat Fisher, Registrar, Rod Coles, Patty Kirk, and Gerald Drucker of the County Clerk's Office, and Ryan Mack of ES&S.

The Kanawha County Commission conducted the Public Pre-Test Inspection at 7:00 p.m. with Doris Smith, Republican Observer, and Damron Bradshaw, Democratic Observer present. Tests of all 16 PC Memory Cards, containing all 160 Precincts were tested and verified error free. The Kanawha County Clerk, Vera McCormick, ES&S technician, Ryan Mack, and County Attorney, Marc Slotnick, verified the test deck was properly completed, counted, and recorded, as evidenced by the attached documentation.

The Public Pre-Test and Inspection was complete at 7:17 p.m. The Commission moved to affirm the results of the Pre-Test and to adjourn until the convening of the After-Test at the conclusion of the evening of October 4, 2011.


